

## Fingerless Gloves



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One size fits most.

### Materials:

175 yards worsted weight Yarn  
Size 6 double pointed needles  
Tapestry needle

Cast on 36 stitches, and divide stitches as follows:

Needle 1: 9 stitches

Needle 2: 18 stitches

Needle 3: 9 stitches

Work in K2, P2 rib for 1.5 inches.

Switch to stockinette stitch (knit every row in the round) and work even until piece measures 3 inches from cast-on edge.

### Thumb Gusset:

Row 1: On Needle 1, k6, place marker, m1, k1, m1, place marker, k2. Knit across Needles 2 & 3.

Row 2, and every following even row: K across all sts.

Row 3: On Needle 1, k6, sm, m1, knit to next marker, m1, sm, k2, knit across Needles 2 & 3.

Repeat Rows 2 & 3 until you have 11 sts between the stitch markers.

Next Row: K6, slip next 11 sts for thumb to stitch holder (or use a piece of waste yarn), continue knitting across row.

Work even (knit every row) until piece measures 5 inches from cast-on edge.

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Divide for fingers:

Knit to last 4 sts on Needle 2. Place sts just worked (from Needles 1 & 2) on scrap yarn or stitch holders. Transfer first 4 sts from Needle 3 onto dpns; place remainder of stitches from Needle 3 on stitch holders or waste yarn. Remaining stitches on needles will be used for the pinky finger of mitten. Divide evenly among dpns, knit across sts, and join to work in the round. Knit 5 rounds even. Bind off loosely.

Ring Finger: Transfer next 9 sts from stitch holders to dpns. Join yarn and begin working in the round, picking up 2 or 3 sts from space next to adjacent finger (the one you just worked). Work 5 rounds even and bind off loosely.

Middle Finger: Transfer next 9 sts from stitch holders to dpns. Join yarn and begin working in the round, picking up 2 or 3 sts from space next to adjacent finger (the one you just worked). Work 5 rounds even and bind off loosely.

Index Finger: Transfer last 9 sts from stitch holders to dpns. Join yarn and begin working in the round, picking up 2 or 3 sts from space next to adjacent finger (the one you just worked). Work 5 rounds even and bind off loosely.

Thumb: Transfer sts on stitch holder or waste yarn to dpns and divide evenly among 3 needles. Join yarn; pick up and knit 2 or 3 stitches from gap where thumb is joined to hand. Work even for 12 rounds, or until just the tip of the thumb emerges from the mitten.

Next Round: \*K1, K2tog, repeat from \* to end

Next Round: K all sts.

Next Round: K2tog to end.

Break yarn, thread a tapestry needle, and draw yarn through remaining sts on thumb.
